



YOUTH TOUR CONTEST

RULES - INFORMATION - DATES

All high school juniors in the area served by Northwestern Electric, regardless of whether their families are Cooperative members or not, are eligible to enter the contest.

Northwestern Electric selects the winners of the contest from contestants who take a written exam over materials furnished by the Cooperative.

From the test scores, the top four students are selected for a final judging and they compete in an interview process on Monday, March 26, 2012, at Northwestern Electric's Woodward office. At that time, the students are asked a series of questions and judged on subject knowledge, originality and personality. The top two winners have the choice of an all expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., or a \$250 scholarship and the opportunity to attend the Touchstone Energy Leadership Summit. The next two winners receive the remaining prizes. The trip to Washington, D.C. is June 15-21, 2012.

The test is given at Northwestern Electric's Woodward office located at 2925 Williams Avenue on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, March 5-7, 2012, between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. The test may be offered at your school. Please check with your counselor.
